EMERGENCY RESOLUTION- PUBLIC WORKS

Health and Safety of Students and Staff at Beverly Hills High School -
Refurbishment of Existing Elevator

On Motion of Member _____, seconded by Member _____,
the following resolution is adopted by the Governing Board of the Beverly Hills Unified School
District.

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen at Beverly Hills High School Building L following
an assessment by District Staff; and

WHEREAS, the existing elevator at Beverly Hills High School has recently experienced a
series of outages for various reasons related to the existing mechanical system, which is
proprietary. Repairs have corrected each immediate issue, but have not mitigated future issues.
Administration has researched the issue and determined that modernizing the system to also
include generic parts, would provide for ease of service, and ready access to parts to correct the
service issues.

WHEREAS, the District must address the situation as an immediate health and safety
concern for the continuation of classes and/or to avoid danger to life or property; AND

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code Section 20113 (school districts) provides that public
agencies may, with the unanimous approval of the governing board and approval of the
county superintendent of schools, contract for the performance of labor and purchase of
materials without advertising for or inviting bids in an emergency when such work is
necessary to permit the continuance of existing school classes or to avoid danger to life
and property;

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, That the Governing Board of the Beverly
Hills Unified School District has determined that these circumstances constitute an
emergency condition and request approval from the county superintendent of schools to
enter the contract for:

Replacing existing proprietary controls with a microprocessor based serial link system.
New car and hall way fixtures. All new wiring to be installed throughout elevator car &
hoist way. New FCU infrared sensing edge for door protection. Without advertising or
inviting bids pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 20113.

Estimated Cost: \$149,418.00.

With the approval of the County Superintendent of Schools, the Board will make a contract for the performance of labor and furnishing of materials or supplies.
