

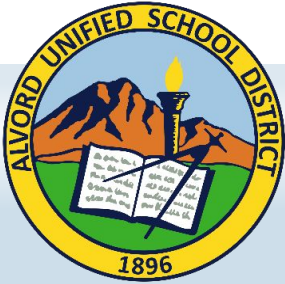

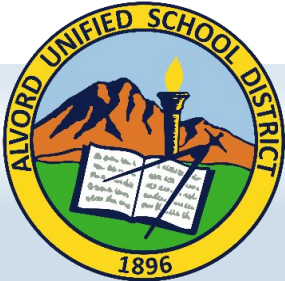

Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant Plan

Under California *Education Code (EC)* 43521 (b), Alvord Unified School District is required to design a plan for a **learning recovery program** that, at minimum, provides supplemental instruction and supports social and emotional well-being of students in the following groups:

- low-income
- English learners
- foster youth
- homeless students, students with disabilities
- students at risk of abuse, neglect, or exploitation
- disengaged students
- students who are below grade level, at risk of graduating, and/or credit deficient



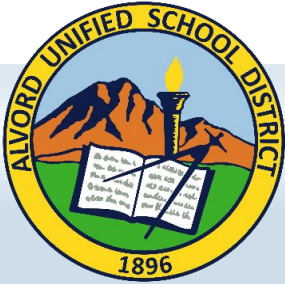

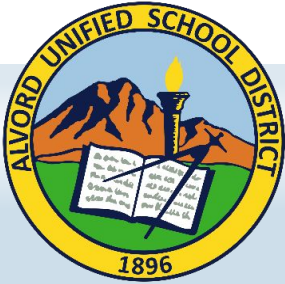

- *Additional hours for certificated/classified/management in preparation of re-opening and in-person instruction*





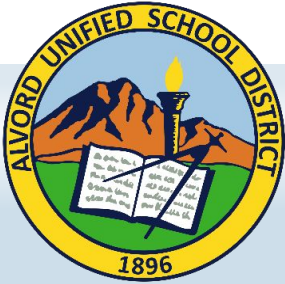

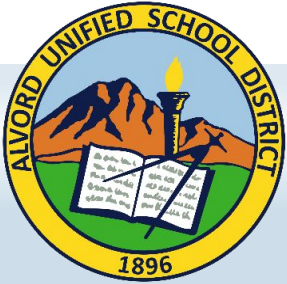
Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant Plan Fiscal Requirements

- **85%** of apportionment for expenditures related to **in-person services** in any of the seven strategies described
- **10%** of the funding is allocated to **paraprofessionals in providing supplemental instruction and support**
- **15%** of its apportionment to improve services for students participating in **distance learning** or to **support activities intended to prepare for in-person instructional services** are offered

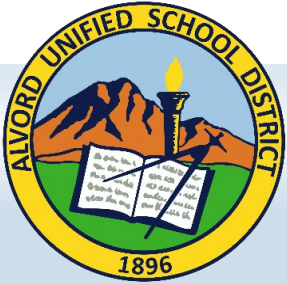

AUSD will coordinate this funds in the following ways:





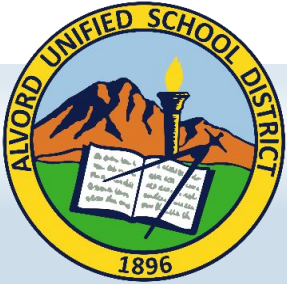
