Trustee Mr. Robert Schwandt stated that he has received positive feedback from administrators, a teacher, and students regarding the Summer School Credit Recovery Program. Mr. Schwandt also stated that this new program will help students with the learning loss due to the pandemic. CBO, Dusty Nevatt stated the Education Protection Act is a component of the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), which is generated from student attendance.
