

**NapaLearns and Napa Valley Unified School District
Memorandum of Understanding for NapaLearns Grants for NVUSD 2019-20**

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 1 day of July 2019, by and between, NapaLearns, a California 501(c)3 non-profit corporation, and the Napa Valley Unified School District (hereinafter referred to as "District").

WHEREAS, NapaLearns is committed to working with the District to promote the implementation of educational innovation for all students in the District; and

WHEREAS, the District seeks community partners to promote and support the educational goals of the District; and

WHEREAS, NapaLearns and the District desire to set forth the terms and conditions upon which NapaLearns shall partner with the District in the promotion of student centered learning with a focus on initiatives that may measurably close opportunity and access gaps for students where these gaps historically persist; and

WHEREAS, NapaLearns and the District desire to set forth the terms and conditions upon which NapaLearns shall partner with the District in the promotion of inquiry based learning, math literacy in grades K-12, CSTEM with computing and robotics, and teacher training and coaching

WHEREAS, NapaLearns and the District are working together in the creation of vibrant and highly qualified workforce to support the local community, and

WHEREAS, the District has representation on the NapaLearns Board through which the District's educational goals are championed; and

WHEREAS, the District and NapaLearns seek standardization in the funding, accounting, and reporting of their jointly agreed upon initiative programs and projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. NapaLearns provides \$125,000 in grant funds to NVUSD for initiatives (Attachment A) between NapaLearns and the District in support of the partnership described above. Grants funds must be expended between July 1, 2019 and June 30, 2020.
2. NVUSD will invoice NapaLearns for program expenses.
3. NapaLearns shall remit payment within 30 calendar days after receiving invoice from NVUSD.
4. Under no circumstances shall NVUSD or NapaLearns reimburse more than the agreed upon grant without amending the MOU between NVUSD and NapaLearns.
5. This Agreement may be renewed for additional one-year terms commencing July 1, 2019, subject to mutual agreement of both parties.
