

Mentis Agreement MOU Summary

Term of this agreement: July 01, 2018 – June 30, 2020.

Napa Valley Unified School District will:

- Provide confidential counseling spaces for Mentis counseling services
 - Counseling services will be provided on-site on school grounds
 - Rooms must ensure confidentiality and have a working telephone
 - All locations where services will be provided will meet the fire and safety rules and regulations
 - Teens Connect and other therapeutic group will be provided in a space that comfortably accommodates at least 9 people at no cost to Mentis
- Work collaboratively with Mentis counselors in case coordination and identification of students who may benefit from individual counseling services. Schools will also assist with prevention group formation.
- Maximize the time of the Mentis counselor thru referrals
- NVUSD will provide WiFi access
- Identify a contact person to serve as a liaison between schools and Mentis to support services provided to schools.

Mentis will:

- Provide school based services based upon staffing and resources to include:
 - Individual and group counseling to assigned students at no cost to NVUSD. Depending on funding and school interest, potential sites include:
 - American Canyon Middle School
 - Harvest Middle School
 - Redwood Middle School
 - Silverado Middle School
 - River Middle School
 - American Canyon High School
 - Napa High School
 - Vintage High School
 - New Tech High School
 - Valley Oak High School
- Make an effort to limit Mentis therapists to each school in order to encourage relationship between Mentis therapist and Wellness Team
- Participate as part of the Wellness Team in the determination and identification of the Mentis therapist caseload
- Ensure Mentis supervisor will meet quarterly (or as needed) with Project Director to discuss administrative and programmatic issues
- Mentis will exchange information with the NVUSD Wellness Team in compliance with FERPA/HIPAA regarding students for consultation purposes.

****NVUSD shall not pay for any expenses and services provided under this agreement.**

Mentis will serve as the fiscal agent for this collaboration and receive all private financial contributions to this project. Mentis will compensate Teens Connect for their involvement in this program**

WORK TO BE PERFORMED

MOU for Services: Napa Valley Unified School District and Mentis 7/1/18 – 6/30/20

The Napa Valley Unified School District Student Services Department provides physical and mental health support to middle and high school students. NVUSD Student Services is focused on the health, well-being and academic success of Napa's middle and high school students. Each school site has a Wellness Team comprised of school counselors, a school social worker, a school psychologist, a school nurse & health aid, and a parent liaison, who help students and their families navigate the complex issues of stress, trauma, suicide, bullying, depression, self-esteem, and relationships.

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- Make an effort to limit Mentis therapists to each schools in order to encourage relationship between Mentis therapist and the Wellness Team
- Participate as part of the Wellness Team in the determination and identification of the Mentis therapist caseload

- Ensure Mentis supervisor will meet as needed with Project Director to discuss administrative and programmatic issues
- Provide timely reports and address concerns as needed
- Notify Wellness Team about capacity issues including caseload and waitlist
- Mentis will exchange information with NVUSD Wellness Team in compliance with FERPA/HIPAA regarding students for consultation purposes.
