
What is a high quality CTE Course?

### **Dual Enrollment**

High school student enrolled in a college course while in high school, at no cost to the student; UC/CSU transferable

- → AP Calculus = Math 180/Math 181
  - ♦ 8 units Calculus/Analytic Geometry
- → ASL II = Sign 101/Sign 102
  - ♦ 8 units of American Sign Language
- → English 12 = English 1A/1C
  - 4 units Composition, 4 units Critical Thinking



## Career Pathways Articulation

Students complete an articulation at the end of their high school course and receive college course credit on a Mt. SAC transcript at no cost to BUSD students.
