## CBA-NVEA Article 4.1.1

Supplemental Salary (for work within the school day): Those unit members appointed by the Board to serve in positions such as Middle School Team Leaders, and Elementary Teacher in Charge, shall receive stipends as per the Stipend Schedule. Said appointments shall be made in the sole, exclusive, and final judgment of the Board.

Every year during the months of January and February a committee will review the budget for the following academic year and will determine by the end of February the number of stipends to be available on July 1<sup>st</sup>.

The committee shall determine one of the following three options:

- 1) Full implementation of the list of stipends
- 2) Which stipends from the list will be active the following year
- 3) No funding for stipends
