## LCFF Priority 6: Local Climate

**CDE** - Local educational agencies will provide a narrative summary of the local administration and analysis of a local climate survey that captures a valid measure of student perceptions of school safety and connectedness. **BUSD** - The percentage of students indicating that they feel a part of the school was 78% for  $5^{th}$  grade, 60% for  $7^{th}$  grade, 55% for 9th grade, and 49% for  $11^{th}$  grade.

**BUSD** - The percentage of students perceiving school as a safe or very safe place was 86% for 5<sup>th</sup> grade, 72% for 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and 65% for 9<sup>th</sup> grade, and 65% for 11<sup>th</sup> grade.

# **LCFF Priority 7:** Access to a Broad Course of Study

<b>CDE</b> : A narrative summary of the extent to which all students have access to and are enrolled in a broad course of study.	<ul> <li>BUSD: For the 2018-19 year, 100% of Bonita Unified School District's students had full access to a broad course of study.</li> <li>In grades 1-6: English, mathematics, social sciences, science, visual and performing arts, health, physical education.</li> <li>In grades 7-12: English, social sciences, foreign language or languages, physical education, science, mathematics, visual and performing arts, applied arts, and Career Technical Education.</li> </ul>	
	BUSD continues to review and increase relevant offerings.
