This **Memorandum of Understanding** is between the Napa Valley Unified School District and Napa Police Department. It shall serve as the Operational Agreement as required pursuant to the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services ("Cal OES") Bullying & School Violence Advocacy (XB) Program for Grant period January - December, 2020, as stated in its Request for Proposal.

Napa Valley Unified School District and **Mentis** as the community based nonprofit partner, will assist students harmed by bullying and other crimes and coordinate services through its Student Services Department as follows:

- Identify and make appropriate referrals to **Napa Police Department**
- Collaborate with School Resource Officers to support students
- Teach students how to utilize the Tip 411 texting program to report bullying and school violence

Napa Police Department agrees to:

- Continue the Tip 411 regional bullying and crime reporting text line.
- Communicate content of reports to SRO's and schools as appropriate.
- Continue to provide Tip411 administrative access to NVUSD Director of Student Services in order to access data from student reports.
- Explore with NVUSD ways to potentially add phone call features, other anonymous tip options.

The signatures below indicate acknowledgement of the agreement and commitments under this Memorandum of Understanding. This agreement shall be in effect upon funding of the *Cal OES Bullying and School Violence Advocacy (XB) Program* anticipated start date of January 1, 2020 and end date of December 31, 2020.
