Background:

The Food Services Department is requesting authorization to extend the contract for Fresh Bread Products to Moreno Bros. Distribution for the 2020-2021 School Year.

RFP 2019/2020-02 Fresh Bread Products

The Board of Education awarded Fresh Bread Products RFP 2019/2020-02 to Moreno Bros. at the June 4, 2019 board meeting. The term of the contract was for one (1) year, with an additional two (2) year renewal period. The District is in the second year of the contract and is seeking approval to extend the contract through the 2021/2022 School Year. This will be the second and final extension of this contract.
