The subject areas covered include but are not limited to Credit Recovery, History, Nova Net, Mental Health, Home and Hospital, Physical Education, Science and Sports.

EDUCATION CODE: 44256(b) The governing board of a school district by resolution may authorize the holder of a multiple subject teaching credential or a standard elementary credential to teach any subject in departmentalized classes to a given class or group of students below grade 9, provided that the teacher has completed at least 12 semester units, or six upper division or graduate units, of coursework at an accredited institution in each subject to be taught. The authorization shall be with the teacher's consent.

EDUCATION CODE: 44258.7(b) allows a full-time teacher who holds a credential in a subject other than physical education *to coach a competitive sport for which the students receive physical education credit* for one period a day, if that teacher has completed a minimum of 20 clock hours of first aid instruction appropriate to the specific sport. Action by the local governing board is required.

EDUCATION CODE: 44263 allows the holder of a teaching credential to serve, by resolution of the governing board and with the consent of the teacher, in a departmentalized class if the teacher has completed eighteen semester units of course work, or nine semester units of upper division or graduate course work, in the subject to be taught.

EDUCATION CODE: 44865 provides staffing options for specified types of programs. *A valid teaching credential issued by the State Board of Education or the Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing, based on a bachelor's degree, student teaching, and special fitness to perform, shall be deemed qualifying for assignment as a teacher in the following assignments, provided that the assignment of a teacher to a position for which qualifications are prescribed by this section shall be made only with the consent of the teacher:*
