Initial Step Placement (Confidential, Classified Management, and Certificated Management):

Initial step placement shall be established by the Superintendent or Designee; step advancement is annual with a satisfactory rating by the Superintendent or Designee.

Longevity (Confidential/Classified Management):

A classified manager/confidential employee shall move to Step 10 after 10 years of service in the Alvord Unified School District as a manager/classified employee.

A classified manager/confidential employee shall move to Step 15 after 15 years of service in the Alvord Unified School District as a manager/classified employee.

A classified manager/confidential employee shall move to Step 20 after 20 years of service in the Alvord Unified School District as a manager/classified employee.

Longevity (Certificated Management):

A certificated manager shall move to Step 10 after 10 years of service in the Alvord Unified School District as a manager/certificated employee.

A certificated manager shall move to Step 15 after 15 years of service in the Alvord Unified School District as a manager/certificated employee.

A certificated manager shall move to Step 20 after 20 years of service in the Alvord Unified School District as a manager/certificated employee.

Doctoral Stipend: \$1,500

Holidays and Vacation (Confidential/Classified Management)*

Per Board Policy 4361, each classified manager/confidential employee shall be entitled up to twenty-two (22) days of vacation annually after 5 years consecutive employment. Classified management/confidential employees may carry over a maximum of 22 days vacation time from one year to the next. Each regular 12-month classified management/confidential employee shall from the date of employment be credited with and entitled to twenty-two days of vacation annually. Each less than 12-month classified/confidential employee shall from the date of hire be credited with and entitled to a pro-rated amount of days of vacation annually.
