AFFILIATE PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT
2021-22**

BACKGROUND

The Inlandia Institute desires to enter affiliate partnerships with other cultural organizations to recognize, support and expand literary activity in all of its forms through community programs.

Affiliates are site specific or programmatic organizations that have a mission, goals, and a purpose complimentary and/or compatible to those of the Inlandia Institute. Affiliates are organizations that desire to provide increased or enhanced cultural, literary programming in all of its formats to a broad audience. They are groups who wish to work collaboratively with others to fully realize this desire.

The Inlandia Institute wishes to enter into an Affiliates Agreement with the Alvord Unified School District with the express purpose of facilitating a six-week graphic novel writing workshop for the 2021-22 school year, and for the receipt of funds sufficient to supply the presenter with honoraria commensurate with presenter's request.

AGREEMENT

Under the Inlandia/AUSD Affiliates Agreement Inlandia Institute agrees to:

1. Solicit Presenter and Negotiate Presenter Agreement: From a mutually determined and confirmed choice of workshop leader for La Sierra High School.
2. Coordinate Presenter, in cooperation with AUSD.
3. Pay Presenter in accordance with previously mutually agreed upon honoraria requests, and will be responsible for soliciting W-9 forms and processing year-end 1099s.

Under the Inlandia/AUSD Affiliates Agreement AUSD Agrees to:

1. Confirm Acceptance of the proposed Inlandia Affiliate Events to the Inlandia Institute no later than two weeks after receiving the program proposal.
2. List Inlandia Institute as a Named Sponsor and include Inlandia Institute's logo on all printed and electronic materials relating to the workshops, if required.

The Institute also agrees to bring added value to AUSD as an Affiliate through:

- Listing AUSD as a project partner on Inlandia Institute's website and materials.

As an Affiliate, AUSD also agrees to:

- Assign a contact person for Inlandia staff and workshop leader;
- Provide access to all necessary facilities;
- Grant the Inlandia Institute permission to use its name as an Affiliate in promotional materials, grant applications and fund solicitation.
