PURPOSE: Norte Vista Ag students (not to exceed 40 and to be selected from the attached list. Not all students will be staying at the fair over night or for the full duration of the fair) would like to again request permission from the School Board to attend the Riverside County Livestock show to be held at the Indio Fairgrounds to exhibit their agriculture projects.

Student projects are an integral part of the instruction in all Ag courses. Participation in the fair is an opportunity for students to show what they have learned by competing with their project against other Ag students from throughout Riverside County. The livestock show is also where many student projects culminate with the marketing of the projects at the Junior Livestock Auction.

TRANSPORTATION:

Students will be transported in district vehicles driven by Mr. Hively, Mrs. Putnam, and Ms. Chappell who are all district approved drivers. They may ride with their own parent. Students may not transport themselves nor may they ride with parents of other students.

ACCOMODATIONS: All students staying overnight at the fair will remain on the fairgrounds in Norte Vista FFA's designated camp area. Male and Female students will be housed separately. Overnight Chaperones are listed above.

STUDENT COSTS: Cost to students will include meals at approximately \$50.00 per student for the week. Meals will be prepared by Ag Booster. Livestock exhibit fees ranging from \$10.00 - \$20.00 depending upon the type of animal exhibited.
